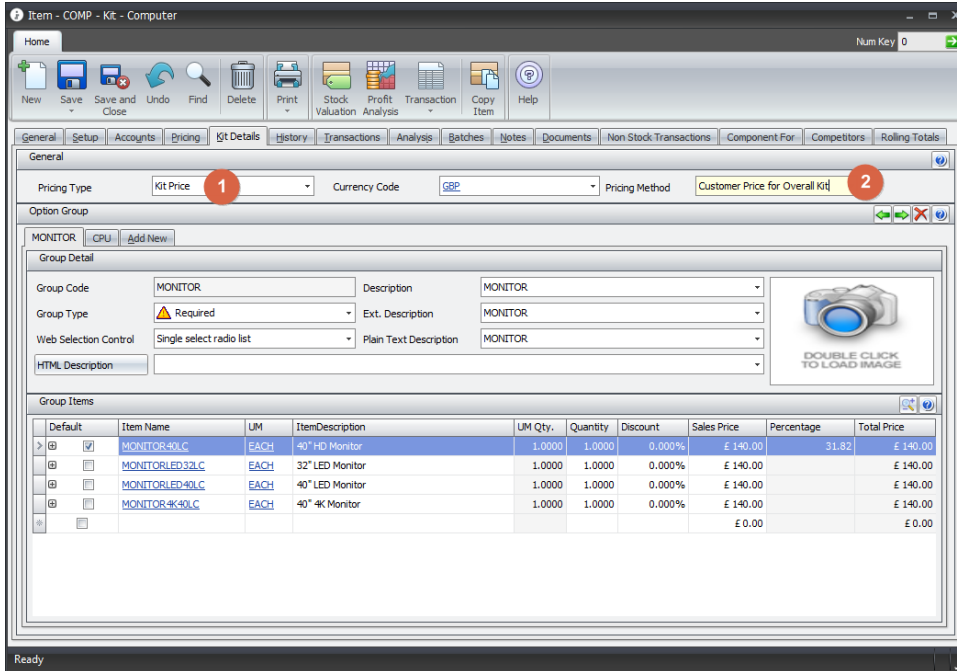




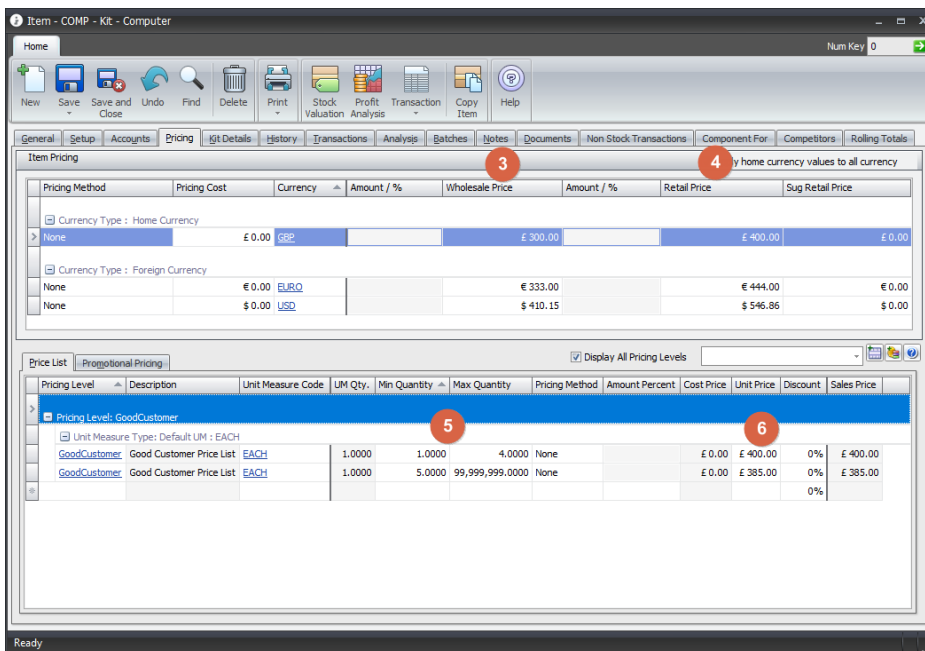
# How Pricing works for Kit Items

There are a few different ways you can set prices for Kits



If the Kit item is set to Kit Price (1) and the Pricing Method is set to 'Customer Price for Overall Kit' then the Item would go onto a sales order as one Item (not individual components) If you have set a Wholesale (3) or Retail (4) price for the item it will use this.

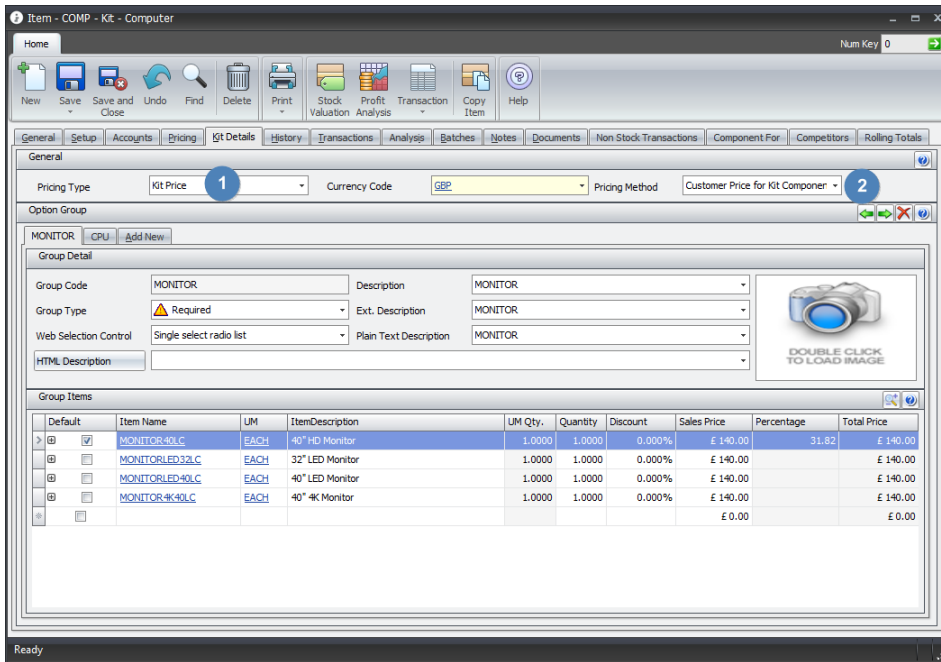
Kits can also be added into Price lists. Having the settings like above will allow you to add it to a price list and set Quantity Breaks like you do for normal Stock Items.



Above you can see the Computer Kit is added into a Price list with Quantity Break (5) prices (6)

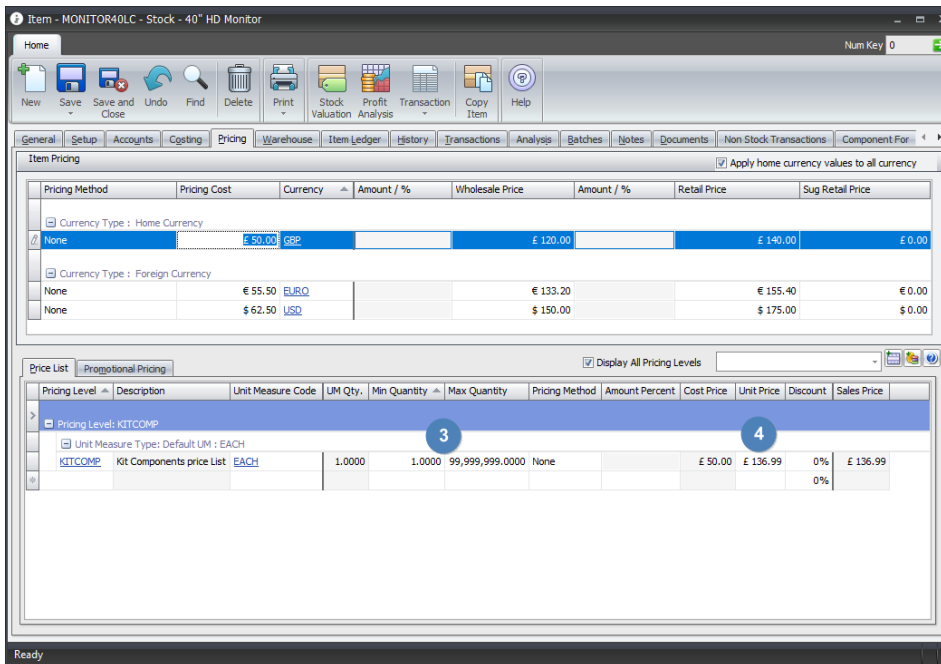


## How Pricing works for Kit Items



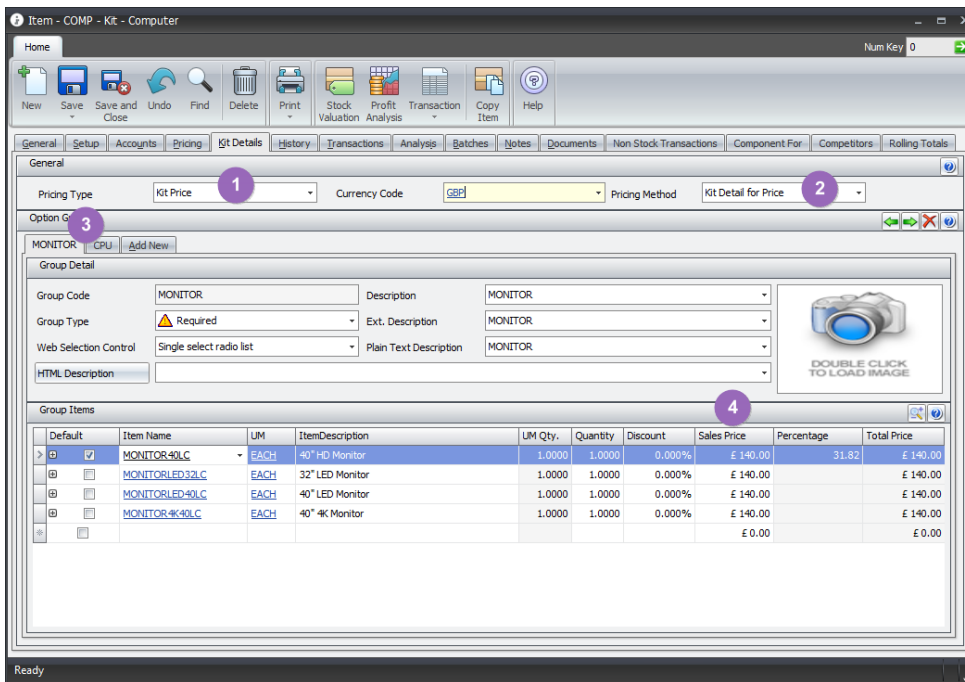
If the Kit item is set to Kit Price (1) and the Pricing Method (2) is set to 'Customer Price for Kit Components' then the Item would go onto a Sales Order as one Item (not individual components) but the Price for the Kit would be calculated by the component prices.

Looking at the Stock Item below we can see it's been added into a price list. If the customer was on this price list, then it would take any Quantity Breaks (3) (if there were any) and the Unit price would pull from here (4)





## How Pricing works for Kit Items



If the Kit item is set to Kit Price (1) and the Pricing Method (2) is set to 'Kit Detail for Price' then the Item would go onto a Sales Order as one Item (not individual components) but the Price for the Kit would be set per each group in the kit (3) and the Sales Price in the detail section at the bottom (4)

If you use 'Kit Detail for Price' then you cannot have Quantity Breaks. You are doing a fixed price based on the components in the Kit.

If the Customer was set to get an overall % discount on their account then this would still add the discount to the kit once it has been entered on an order.



## How Pricing works for Kit Items

All of the above options can be used in the same way with the Pricing Type set to 'Item Price'

If the kit is setup with the options below the items would be added to the order individually rather than as 1 line. The prices would be listed next to each component item line on the sales order.
